

# Notice of a Positive COVID-19 Case in School

Saturday, November 26, 2021

Dear families,

This message is to inform you that **three students at James R. Henderson have tested positive for COVID-19**. One case was already isolating from a cohort that was dismissed following a positive case November 24, so there is no new impact to the school community. The other two positive cases will require the one class/cohort to enter self-isolation. Those identified as close contacts of the positive cases will be given specific guidance in messages sent from KFL&A Public Health through school communication systems.

## What do you need to do?

1. If you receive a **Positive COVID-19 Case in your Student's Cohort** message from KFL&A Public Health, follow the specific guidance outlined in that message.
2. **Continue to monitor for symptoms** of COVID-19 and screen all students daily. Most cases of COVID-19 are acquired in the home setting; vigilant screening is recommended. Do not send students to school if they are sick or symptomatic. Go to [covid-19.ontario.ca/school-screening/](https://covid-19.ontario.ca/school-screening/) **AND** [kflaph.ca/SchoolScreening](https://kflaph.ca/SchoolScreening) **daily** and follow the instructions provided. If you have symptoms of COVID-19, book a PCR test at an assessment center or participating pharmacy.
