Your answers will be combined with the answers from Limestone staff, families, other students and community partners to create a list of priorities and goals that will make up the main part of the strategy. The information about your identity and where you go to school will be used to understand what you need and how your school can support you better.

We will share results with the public in the Fall and Spring of 2021-2022 to help more people understand student mental health, substance use issues and well-being.
