Objectives:

To provide an update on the Long Term Accommodation Plan prepared by Ameresco Asset Sustainability Group Inc.

History/Background:

In March 2015 the Ministry released a new *Pupil Accommodation Review Guideline* (PARG) as well as revised *Facility Partnership Guidelines*, now known as *Community Planning and Partnership Guidelines* (CPPG).

These guidelines require school boards to update their respective policies on pupil accommodation guidelines and community partnerships as soon as possible. At the January 19, 2016 Education, Policy and Operations Committee meeting a new Community Planning & Partnerships Policy #20 and a revised Pupil Accommodation Review Policy #15 were approved by Trustees.

These guidelines also require that school boards have a long term accommodation plan (LTAP) that addresses the future needs of their students. School boards are expected to share this information with municipal and community partners at an annual meeting so that external entities may have sufficient time to respond to presented opportunities, such as facility partnerships or board surplus space in accordance with O.Reg. 444/98.

At the September 23, 2015 Property/Operations Committee meeting, Trustees approved a motion to engage a consulting firm to prepare a LTAP for the Board. At the January 13, 2016 Regular Board meeting, Trustees were advised that Ameresco Asset Sustainability Group Inc. was the consulting firm selected after a competitive RFQ process was undertaken.

Observations/Analysis:

At the March 22, 2016 Education, Policy and Operations Committee meeting, Ms. Cynthia Clarke from Ameresco Asset Sustainability Group Inc. presented to Trustees a Draft Findings Report focusing on the most recent enrolment and school-by-school utilization data over a 15-year period, 2015-2016 to 2029-2030. At this meeting it was mentioned that a LTAP would be presented at the May 24, 2016 Education, Policy and Operations Committee meeting.

The May 24, 2016 LTAP prepared by Ameresco includes, updated enrolment information as prepared by Baragar Systems as of March 2016, the most recent Facility Condition Information as of April 2016 as well as current information on school programming changes planned for the 2016-2017 school year, such as the opening of Molly Brant Elementary School and the transition of QECVI students to other Kingston secondary school locations in advance of the demolition of that facility.

The LTAP has a number of recommendations concerning school consolidations/closures, new schools/additions and boundary changes over the 15-year planning horizon. These recommendations are intended to improve operating efficiencies and to provide stronger program opportunities for LDSB students.

The attached document is a summary of the recommendations contained in the LTAP.

Next Steps:

A copy of the Long Term Accommodation Plan (LTAP) as prepared by Ameresco Asset Sustainability Group Inc. will be posted on the Board website for information purposes.

A Community Planning and Partnership meeting(s) will be scheduled in September 2016 with municipal and community partners to share the Long Term Accommodation Plan (LTAP) and to receive and discuss relevant planning information.

Summary:

It should be noted that Trustees are not required to approve or endorse the Long Term Accommodation Plan (LTAP) prepared by Ameresco Asset Sustainability Group Inc., including its recommendations.

In accordance with Pupil Accommodation Review Policy #15, prior to the Pupil Accommodation Review (PAR) occurring:

- Staff will need to prepare an Initial Staff Report and present to Trustees, and
- Based upon the Initial Staff Report, Trustees may approve the formation of a Pupil Accommodation Review (PAR) for a group of schools or for a single school.

Recommendation:

That this report and the Long Term Accommodation Plan (LTAP) prepared by Ameresco Asset Sustainability Group Inc. be received for information purposes.
